

**Victor J. Andrew High School
Athletic Booster Club
Meeting Minutes from February 8, 2017**

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 p.m. by Rena Sheehan, followed by introductions of all in attendance.

Secretary's Report:

- A motion was made by Mike Sheehan to waive the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting, and to accept the meeting minutes. Tricia O'Connor seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Treasurer's Report:

- There is approximately \$98,784 remaining in the account. This is \$4,732 more than last year at this time. The YTD income through February was \$24,828 which was \$11,549 better than the prior year.
- Mike Sheehan motioned to accept the treasurer's report and Lesley Magnabosco seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Spirit Wear Report:

- Class of 2021 T-shirts were sold at freshman registration. 298 were ordered at a cost of \$1788, and 294 were sold for \$15 each, resulting in a gain of \$2612.
- The Festive Pines sale in January resulted in sales of \$1050.

Team Rep Updates

- The Poms team attended a national-level competition in Florida and placed 14th in the nation.
- There have been questions about why teams are scheduled to work concessions for other sports. The money raised from concessions benefits all athletes. In addition to the purchases made for specific programs, the Booster Club contributes \$600 per month towards the athletic budget, the uniform rotation, fireworks for homecoming, Senior Party, and Andrew Fest.

Team Rep Director Report

- Volunteers (2 per game) are needed for the girls basketball regional games on February 13 at 7:00, February 14 at 6:00 and 7:30, and February 16 at 7:00.
- The boys track meeting will be held on March 7th.
- Concessions will be open for the following events:
 - April 1 – Boys track invite
 - April 9 – Girls track invite
 - April 13 – Junior High track meet

Communication Director Report:

- Tricia will email Mark to fix the link on the website.

Membership Director Report

- A letter will go out to all athletes before next meeting.
- We need some representation at lower levels.
- Rena suggested a separate meeting to discuss ideas and incentives for parents to get involved.
- Changing the scholarship requirements so that involvement beginning freshman year is required.
- Team reps to solicit membership from roster.

Concessions Directors' Report

- All bills have been paid, and there is a \$19,774.46 profit.
- Concessions will be open for Special Olympics on February 18. There are 3 games and 2 students are needed to work.
- There were not as many spectators as expected at the wrestling tournament. There was a lot of waste, and the timing didn't allow for re-ordering of those items that sold out more quickly.

Variety Show Update

- Almost all money is in and only two bills are left to be paid. V-Show resulted in a \$23,000 profit.

Fundraising

- A fundraising director is needed.
- Lesley Magnabosco will look into the Alex and Ani fundraiser, and Keri Malone will email about the Portillo's fundraiser.

Scholarships

- The deadline to apply is March 1st. There is a separate application that must be submitted to the Guidance Department.

Athletic Director's Report:

- Boys bowling – Ethan Gerald qualified for State.
- Girls bowling – Team took 2nd place at Regionals. Noelle Doody and Danielle Stefanski qualified for State.
- Girls basketball – Regionals are coming up.
- Boys basketball – Lots of close games
- Cheer – Took 6th at sectionals
- Poms – Placed 9th at State and 14th at Nationals
- Boys Swimming – Placed 2nd in Conference. Pete Maiolo placed 1st in diving
- Wrestling – 5 wrestlers advanced to Sectionals, and there were 3 Regional Champs.
- Track is in full swing.
- Tryouts for other sports are coming up.
- VJA hosted many large events over the winter.
- Mr. Dwyer has no athletic requests.

New Business:

- The District 230 Foundation fundraiser is being held on April 1st. Like last year, it's the NCAA basketball final 4 event. The Booster Club will pay for a table.
- Tricia O'Connor won the raffle and designated the money for boys basketball.
