  - Indoor Boys Track- We haven't started yet, first meet is Thursday
  - Varsity Boys Basketball- One more week to go of regular season before playoffs. Great senior night celebration last week. 11-17 (but play Tuesday)
  - Soph Basketball- Our season wraps up at home 02/19 against St. Rita 14-8
  - Freshman Boys Basketball (A&B Teams)- The Freshman team placed 2nd out of 16 teams at the Freshman Tinley Tournament this past weekend. Their goal at summer camp was to make the championship game and they succeeded. This team works hard and truly supports one another. A Team 21-6 / B Team 11-13
  - Boys Swim and Dive Varsity- Enrollment was low this year for the Boys Swim & Dive team. Conference was good, had a few of our swimmers make podium. Sectionals will be held on Saturday, February 21 with Diving in the morning and Swimming after.
  - Varsity Cheer- 19th at State- The Golden Girls placed 3rd at Sectionals, held at Reavis on Saturday, 1/31. The competition season ended this past Friday, 2/6, where the girls took 19th. Senior night is on Thursday, February 19 (we have 12 seniors), and our banquet will be on Tuesday, March 10.
